Editorial Fellowship Submission Guidelines

Funded by the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries the *Green Leaves / Red River* project offers two Editorial Fellowships which will provide the chance for emerging editors to grow their skills capacity, develop networks, create international partnerships, and receive hands-on practical experience in the field.

During the project, Editorial Fellows will:

- Receive a desk space at Centre for Stories,
- Receive a stipend of \$250 per publication,
- Mentor support from Robert Wood.

Centre for Stories will launch eight collections of poetry over the course of 2022 and 2023. You will have the chance to work on four collections over this time period.

1. Applications are invited from people living in Western Australia who identify as Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD), including First Nations and/or People of Colour (FNPOC).
2. Applications are to include a Curriculum Vitae and a statement of intent/purpose.
3. Applications are to be submitted via email to submissions@centreforstories.com with the subject title: Editorial Fellowships Application – [Your Name]
4. Applications open Wednesday 25 May 2022 and close at 11.59pm on Friday 24 June 2022. Late applications will not be considered for selection.
