



Centre for Stories 2023 Mentor Trainee Program Guidelines

1. Applications are invited from people living in Western Australia who identify as CaLD and/or First Nations.
2. Applicants are required to fill out the submission form online at www.centreforstories.com/trainee-program. Please fill out the application form and answer the questions carefully.
3. Applications open 29 May 2023 and close at 11.59pm on 3 July 2023.
4. Successful applications will be contacted by email in the weeks following 3 July 2023.
5. Successful applicants will be paired with an established author of their chosen field for a period of 6 months to support them through the program. During this period, mentors and trainees will have 6 hours of face-to-face or Zoom contact time. Trainees will also have 18 hours of face-to-face or Zoom contact time with their designated mentee.
6. The trainee program will commence in September 2023 with initial consult commencing in August/September 2023.
7. Successful applicants will be profiled on the Centre for Stories' website and social media. On request, successful applicants agree to provide a photograph for publicity purposes.
8. Successful applicants will have the opportunity to attend Centre for Stories events and workshops, attend networking events, interact with other writers, and seek support from Centre for Stories staff.
