





## Centre for Stories 2023 Mentor Trainee Program Guidelines

- 1. Applications are invited from people living in Western Australia who identify as CaLD and/or First Nations.
- Applicants are required to fill out the submission form online at www.centreforstories.com/trainee-program. Please fill out the application form and answer the questions carefully.
- 3. Applications open 29 May 2023 and close at 11.59pm on 3 July 2023.
- 4. Successful applications will be contacted by email in the weeks following 3 July 2023.
- 5. Successful applicants will be paired with an established author of their chosen field for a period of 6 months to support them through the program. During this period, mentors and trainees will have 6 hours of face-to-face or Zoom contact time. Trainees will also have 18 hours of face-to-face or Zoom contact time with their designated mentee.
- 6. The trainee program will commence in September 2023 with initial consult commencing in August/September 2023.
- 7. Successful applicants will be profiled on the Centre for Stories' website and social media. On request, successful applicants agree to provide a photograph for publicity purposes.
- 8. Successful applicants will have the opportunity to attend Centre for Stories events and workshops, attend networking events, interact with other writers, and seek support from Centre for Stories staff.
